Without the records, the electoral results in Venezuela cannot be recognized

- Election results must be fully credible and subject to verification.
- The OIE Network urges the National Electoral Council of Venezuela to make all electoral records public.
- The organizations that are part of the OIE Network offer their support to conduct a statistical, technical, and independent analysis of the results of the electoral records.

Bogotá D.C., July 29, 2024. The organizations that conduct electoral observation in Latin America, gathered in the Electoral Observation and Integrity Network – OIE Network, request the electoral authority of Venezuela to carry out a transparent and public count of the votes and electoral records of the presidential elections held yesterday. The election results must be fully credible and subject to verification by all political organizations, independent national and international electoral observers, and civil society in general.

In this regard, the OIE Network urges the National Electoral Council of Venezuela to make all electoral records public. This information should be made available in images and should be accessible in files by polling station and by duly identified voting site.

However, in the event that the records are not published or are published by the electoral authority without proper traceability, the organizations that are part of the OIE Network offer their support to conduct a statistical, technical, and independent analysis of the results of the records collected on election day by civil society organizations and political parties.

“Without the publication of all the records and their verification and audit, it is not feasible to recognize the electoral results in Venezuela,” emphasized the General Secretariat of the OIE Network, led by Alejandra Barrios Cabrera, Director of the Electoral Observation Mission - MOE Colombia.
